# Deaths



- Naomi Lukungu, died 8<sup>th</sup> March 2016, aged 104
  - At Mwiri for ~45 years from 1935 or 1936
  - School Nurse and Mwiri Legend
- Gordon Silk, died 4<sup>th</sup> April 2016, aged 89
  - Arrived at Mwiri in 1957 with CMS, was Head of Mathematics and House Master, Wako
  - Left in Dec 1963 to become HM of Mukono SS.
- Wanume Kibedi, died 13<sup>th</sup> June 2016, aged 74
  - Head of School, 1960
  - Foreign Minister (aged 29) in early Amin era, Ambassador to UN, solicitor in London, latterly chairperson of Uganda Citizenship and Immigration board.
- Mr. Nambago (nickname 'Brown')
  - Played in Goal for Uganda
  - Last surviving pupil from Kamuli High School?
  - Played violin at Centennial Service at Bugembe, 2011
- Lawrie Peters, wife of Vic, at Mwiri in 1960s, Died July 2016

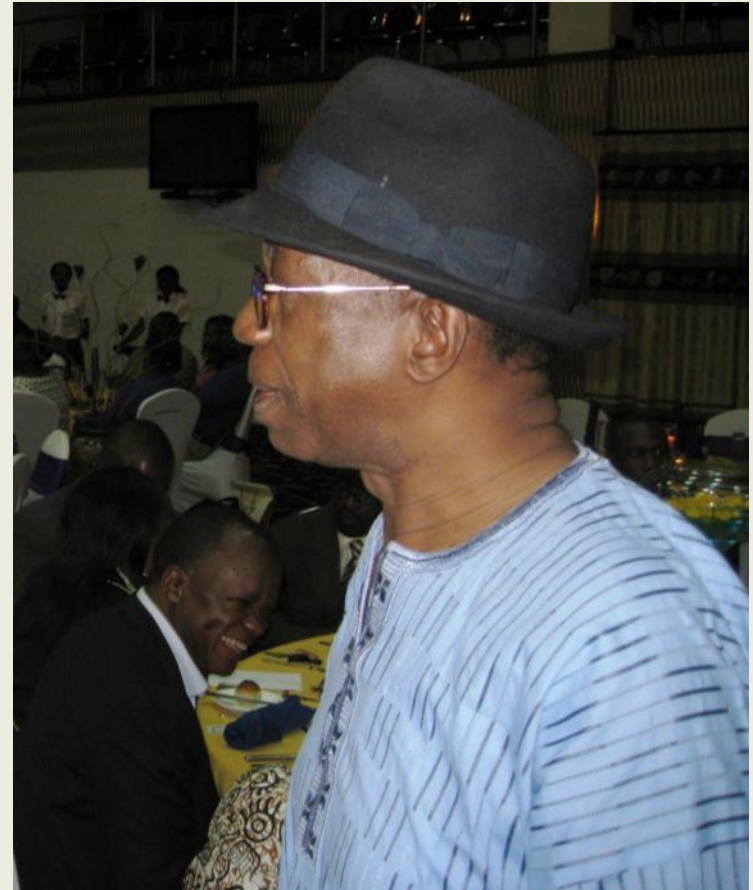
